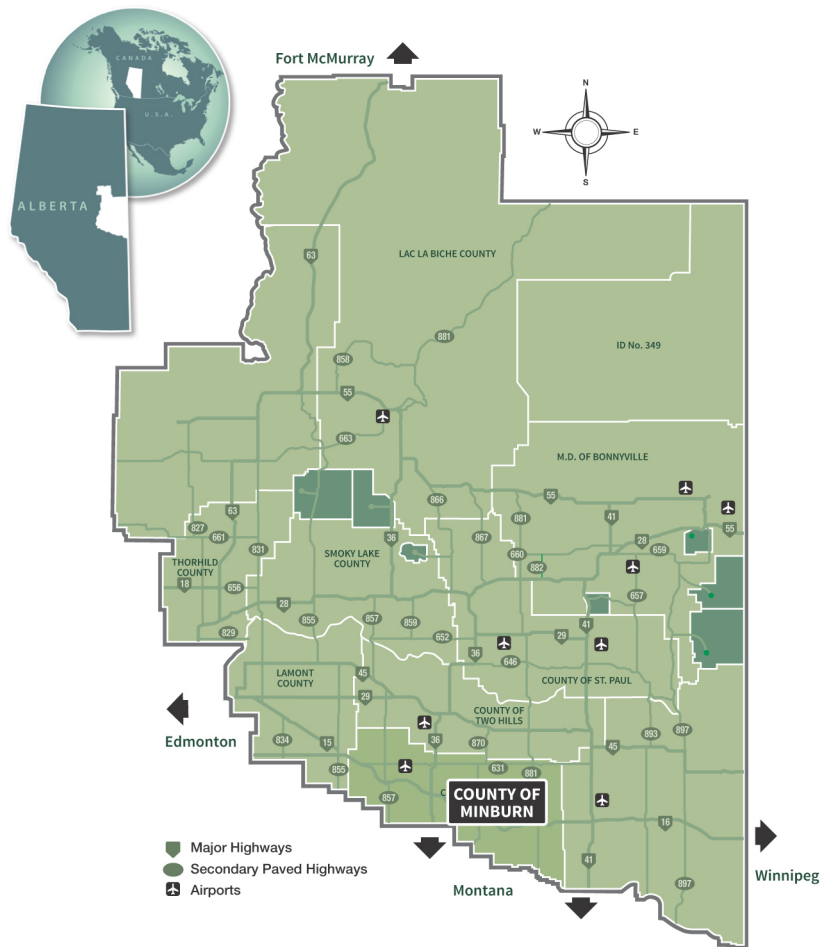


ABOUT THE COUNTY OF MINBURN

Healthcare

First-rate medical services include in-patient and out-patient care, chronic care, occupational and physical therapy, and dental and eye care. East Central Health is the regional health authority, which serves many of the communities within the County of Minburn. The Yellowhead Highway and the network of regional roads ensure all residents easy access to the Mannville Health Care Centre in Mannville and St. Joseph's General Hospital in Vegreville.



Education

The County of Minburn offers a wide range of educational options from daycare to post-secondary. Access to Portage and Lakeland Colleges is available, which offer academic programs and a full range of vocational programs including food preparation, beauty culture, automotives, electronics and business. Expanding curriculum in adult education, literacy tutoring and academic upgrading is also offered. The County has a thriving Early Childhood Services (ECS) program, and Vegmin Learning Network and other community groups also sponsor a variety of adult education courses.



Housing

There is affordable housing in a variety of price ranges. Lot sizes range from urban single lots in the hamlets to full quarter sections.

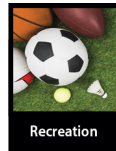

Community Services

There are a number of shopping services found within the County including the Wal-Mart in Vegreville. Emergencies services include:

- Fire protection is provided by three fire departments located within the County: Vegreville Fire Department, Innisfree Fire Department, and Mannville Fire Department.
- Police services are provided by the Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP), with detachments in Vegreville and Vermilion.
- Ambulance services are provided under contract from Prairie Emergency Medical Systems with an ambulance base located in Vermilion, and by Vegreville Emergency Medical Services with an ambulance base located in Vegreville.



Recreation

Throughout the County you will find a wide variety of recreational, tourist and leisure opportunities:

- Golf Courses: Mannville Riverview Golf Course, Vegreville Kinsmen Golf Course.
- Parks/Fishing: Rotary Peace Park, Elks/Kinsmen Park, Lions Community Spray Park, Rainbow Park, Innisfree Trout Pond.
- Vegreville Aquatic and Fitness Centre.
- Wapasu: The Wapasu Recreation Conservancy Park has a day use public recreation facility, which includes a recreation area for sports, a cookhouse, and washrooms. Visitors can enjoy the hiking trails and bird watching.
- Akasu Hill: also known as Sickman Hill is one of the highest points between Edmonton and Winnipeg and provides a spectacular view.
