ABOUT THE TOWN OF LAMONT

The Town of Lamont is located in the southwest of the Alberta HUB region. Alberta HUB is a partnership of municipalities, First Nations, Metis Settlements, post-secondary educational institutions, and business/industry in northeastern Alberta meant to enhance the quality of life and economic interests of this region. Located a short 30 minute drive east of Edmonton on Highway 15, Lamont was described by settlers as "the nicest open country a person could wish for". This progressive, growing community of over 1,700 provides relaxed country living with all the amenities of a larger center including accommodations, fine dining, and shopping. Lamont is an ideal place to start a business and a family.

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OUR TOP INDUSTRIES



Oil and Gas

Located in a resource-rich area, Lamont is in close proximity to the Alberta Industrial Heartland with 20 billion dollars worth of investment and is also part of the Alberta HUB region experiencing 26 billion dollars of oil sands development. There are over 1,700 oil/gas wells in Lamont County, and the Town is ideally located to service the Alberta Oil Sands projects to the north and northeast. Numerous opportunities exist for companies to establish a base in Lamont.



Service Industry (Oil and Gas)

Located close to the educated and skilled Greater Edmonton Area work force, and close to the Alberta Industrial Heartland, Lamont is ideally located for oil, gas and petrochemical industry transportation and servicing. CN Rail runs through the town, and intersects with CP Railway nearby. The Lamont area is well served by major and secondary highways, including a High Load Corridor. Major pipeline corridors run nearby, enhancing Lamont's attractiveness to the service industry.



Agriculture

Lamont is located in Lamont County, where agriculture is a major industry. Lamont County is the third largest county in the Alberta HUB region, with gross farm receipts of \$148 million (2021). There are multiple livestock operations in the county. Farms also produce a variety of crops including canola, wheat and peas. Value-added industries such as farm equipment sales/service, fuels/fertilizers, livestock services and grain handling are located in Lamont.



Transportation

Highways 16 (Yellowhead), 15 and 29 are close to destinations such as Edmonton, which is 65 km southwest of Lamont. Highway 831, a High Load Corridor, runs through Lamont, making the town a perfect logistics center. There is a CN rail line and two nearby airports: Edmonton International and Josephburg.
